## 2019 Jean McKee Resident Scholarship Program Eligibility and Application Requirements

#### SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Two awards of up to \$2,000 are made annually (\$500 per year for up to four years). The scholarship program is funded through private donations and is subject to the availability of funding.

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- Applicant must have been a resident of a housing program administered by the Grand Rapids Housing Commission (GRHC) for the past year.
- Applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from a GRHC employee. This could be a Section 8 Coordinator, Resident Services Specialist, Housing Manager or other staff member who can confirm that the applicant's household is in good standing with the Housing Commission in accordance with GRHC Admissions & Continued Occupancy Policies.
- Program is open to graduating high school seniors, current college or vocational school students, and adult residents seeking to begin or return to college or vocational school. Graduating high school seniors, undergraduate students and participants in the GRHC's Family Self-Sufficiency Program will receive priority status for this program.
- Applicants who are graduating high school seniors and those currently attending college must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 (C+ letter grade). See additional requirements below.
- Applicants seeking to return to college or vocational school must provide an official high school or college transcript which demonstrates that the applicant is a high school graduate and had a cumulative high school or college GPA of at least 2.5. See additional requirements below.
- Applicant must attend an accredited vocational school, community college, college or university as a full-time student.
- Scholarship winners are eligible to renew the scholarship annually for up to four years. Continuing requirements of scholarship winners:
- Must maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA.
- Must maintain enrollment as a full-time student at an accredited vocational school, community college, college or university.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS: ALL APPLICANTS MUST SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING APPLICATION MATERIALS:

- Completed Jean McKee Resident Scholarship Application Form.
- Letter of recommendation from a GRHC employee (your Housing Manager, Section 8 Coordinator, Resident Services Specialist or other GRHC staff member) that shows your household is in good standing with the Housing Commission.
- Short essay (approximately 300 words) on the topic "My career goals and how the educational program I am pursuing will help me reach these goals."

### ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS ARE LISTED BELOW BY APPLICANT STATUS:

### GRADUATING HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR:

- High school transcript that shows high school completion and cumulative GPA of at least 2.5.
- Letter of recommendation from a teacher or administrator at the applicant's high school.
- Letter of acceptance from an accredited vocational school, community college, college or university.

### CURRENT COLLEGE OR VOCATIONAL SCHOOL STUDENT:

- Letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor at applicant's college/school.
- Official college/school transcript that shows:
- -A cumulative GPA of at least 2.5.
- -Student maintained full-time enrollment during the term preceding application.
- -Student is enrolled full-time for the upcoming fall term.

### ADULT SEEKING TO BEGIN OR RETURN TO COLLEGE OR VOCATIONAL SCHOOL:

- Official high school or GED or college transcript which demonstrates that the applicant is a high school graduate and had a cumulative high school or college GPA of at least 2.5.
- Letter of acceptance from an accredited vocational school, community college, college or university.
- Proof of full-time enrollment for the upcoming fall term.

All Scholarship application materials must be received by the GRHC by the application deadline.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: 5 P.M. Monday, May 20, 2019

#### **APPLICATION EVALUATION**

Grand Rapids Housing Commission staff will conduct an initial screening of applications and make recommendations based on the program requirements outlined above. The Housing Commission governing board will review applications from qualified applicants and confirm all Scholarship winners.
