Campau Commons offers 60 apartments in multi-unit buildings and 32 semi-detached duplex units. Layouts offer one to four bedrooms. Features and amenities include:

Located adjacent to a public park and near downtown Grand Rapids, Campau Commons offers affordable apartment living to low-income households, including families, senior citizens and disabled persons.

The 92-unit development features one- to four-bedroom apartments that range in size from 843 to 1,370 square feet. Monthly rents are based on each tenant's ability to pay and are no more than 30 percent of a family's adjusted monthly income. A grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development makes it possible for the Housing Commission to offer rents well below the average rates for comparable apartments in our area.
